Director statement

Improvisation is created spontaneously, without preparation, and therefore is a representation of our uncensored thoughts and feelings. In improvisation, whatever comes out of us, if it is in music, dance or prose, is a true and raw reflection of the inner self, which is why Jazz and the other improvisational arts are so engaging, and why they resonate with audiences so deeply. Simply put, people both recognize and appreciate that which is real. 'Improvisa' was born from real life experiences in improvisation workshops and working with actors while improvising scenes. In the film, Lisa, who is usually reserved and timid, is encouraged by the improvisation exercise to "let loose" which her controlling partner does not appreciate. The workshop quickly leads both Lisa and Michel to expose their true thoughts and feelings, both to themselves, and to each other. Seeing each other for who they are, perhaps for the first time, leads the two to recalibrate their feelings towards each other and reconsider their relationship.
